Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm.

Minutes (Joan Farmer): Minutes from the October meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report (Michael Curran): A fairly quiet month for financial transactions. Check book balance is \$87,874.72 and total operating funds are \$79,461.61. Stadium chairs netted \$40.00. Report accepted and filed for audit.

Director (Kaylee Flynt): Marching Band is over. Concert bands are meeting everyday. Nate Harris is doing the concert band and Kaylee Flynt is doing the Wind Ensemble. They are preparing for the December 22 concert.

President (David Frey): Expressed his thanks to Elizabeth Heston for all of her work with the uniforms this past Marching Band season; to Alex Heston for keeping the website updated; to Scott Karn for his work as chaperone chair; and to Ann Brizee for her fundraising efforts. OMEA contest at Memorial is in April and we need a volunteer to run the concessions. He's putting together a slide show for the band banquet and is looking for pictures. He brought up the possibility of a band trip and/or a performance at the Q or a Monsters or Cavaliers game. Kaylee will explore some trip options. Mike Curran brought up the transportation costs associated with these events and suggested we check with the Board.

Uniforms (Elizabeth Heston): Elizabeth would like to remind students to store their uniforms and make sure to clean the mud off the pants. Kaylee will include uniform maintenance instructions in a future email. Elizabeth will schedule two senior uniform turn-in dates this year.

Website (Alex Heston): There were 352 visits to the website in October and content is up to date.

Chaperones (Scott Karn): The next need for chaperones will be for contest at Mentor High School in March.

Fundraising (Ann Brizee): The Yankee Candle fundraiser was ok. Would like more participation from Greenview and Memorial students. She's considering future fundraisers, perhaps incorporating an incentive.

New Business:

Band camp prepayment information needs to go out in early January and Mike will not be doing it this year so someone needs to take on that responsibility. There was much discussion about the Band Banquet which will be held December 1, 6:30pm, at Borally's, and cost for same. It was determined that we will charge \$20/person which will cover the cost of the food and provide some additional funds for incidental expenses. We also discussed Senior gifts, plaques and director gifts and the financial issues associated with them. Kaylee already has the photos for the senior gifts. Ann Brizee and Elizabeth Heston will put the gifts together (frame and matting). Ann will take care of the banquet mailing; checks and RSVPs will go to Ann. Mike Curran asked Kaylee to have the Band President contact him re the budgeted amount for the Director's gift.
